

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Corinth, Alcorn County, Mississippi intends to replace approximately 6,900 feet of interceptor gravity sewer lines and 24 manholes along Elam Creek. Total estimated cost of the project is \$2,200,000. Funding for the project will be obtained through the Wastewater Pollution Control Revolving Loan Fund (WPCRLF) administered by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ).

A Public Hearing will be held at 2:00 P.M., July 8th, 2021, in the Board Room on the second floor of Corinth City Hall, 300 Childs St, Corinth, MS 38834. The hearing site will be accessible to individuals with disabilities.
